Neighborhood Watch Corner:

Keep unattended vehicles locked. Vehicle thefts increase in the winter months when people leave their unlocked cars running to warm up in the driveway. This can allow an auto thief to hop in and steal your car. Many vehicle "break-ins" are not break-ins at all but were left unlocked. If you leave valuables in your car, lock them in the trunk or hide them from plain view.

For those evening outdoor exercisers, as it is dark earlier in the winter, remember to carry a flashlight. It is helpful to wear lighter colors and/or reflected gear. Remember to walk/run facing traffic and use sidewalks when possible. Continue to lock your homes and keep your garage door closed and secured.

Be a good neighbor, when you see something say something. The Chesapeake Police non-emergency number is 382-6161, or you can file certain incidences on-line using the Citizen's On-Line Reporting System on their website.
